What is involved

+ Off-road assessment

The Occupational Therapy Driving Assessment commences with an off-road assessment to evaluate movement, sensation, coordination, reaction time, vision, cognitive and psychosocial function.

+ On-road assessment

An on-road assessment follows the off-road evaluation. It is completed in a dual controlled vehicle, usually with a licensed driving instructor also present. The client will drive through a standard route to assess driving in accordance with licensing standards.

+ Feedback and report

The outcome of the assessment and next steps are discussed with the client and family following the assessment. A report is provided to the referring party, client and licensing authority.
